DISHWASHING MACHINE

For the first wash of the day:

Remove food scaps from items Fill racks Hollow ware must be inverted - cups must be upside down Put 1 -1½ spoons of washing powder in.

NOTE; WASHING POWDER ONLY NEEDS TO BE ADDED EVERY FOUR OR FIVE CYCLES, DEPENDING ON HOW HEAVILY ITEMS ARE SOILED. *ONLY HALF OF ORIGINAL DOSE*

Close Door Fully

Run hot water tap in sink first to get hot water to machine

Press start button for 1 to 2 seconds

Cycle will be finished in $1\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 minutes

Ready for next rack or tray.

AT END OF DAY - SHUT DOWN PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove overflow pipe (white plug inside machine)
- 2. Close Door
- 3. Push drain switch
- 4. When cycle is finished, open door replace pipe and leave door open so machine has time to air.
